

SALUKI COMPLETE BLOOD COUNT

Blood samples were obtained from healthy Salukis of various ages, genetic backgrounds, activity levels and geographical areas across the US and analyzed at the CVM, MSU

Analysis of the data showed that Salukis have:

- **Higher packed cell volumes (PCV)**
- **Higher Hemoglobin (Hb)**
- **Lower White Blood Cell Counts (WBC)**

These data show that Saluki blood counts are similar to reported normal ranges for Greyhounds
